The country has an auto-parts industry from the former Yugoslavia era and a comparatively large number of skilled workers with high educational background, while lacking in managers who have sufficient knowledge for marketing and cultivating sales channels themselves. To ensure the independence and development of North Macedonia's economy, it is necessary to develop human resources, especially in the fields of investment promotion, trade promotion, and promotion of small and medium enterprises.			[Strategy] Fully utilizing its knowledge, Japan will aim to create a business environment where the private sector can achieve development. In the process, Japan will offer support focusing on the improvement of the investment climate, while seeking effective collaboration with the technical cooperation it has offered so far.
